The Danville community is invited to place new flags at Odd Fellows Cemetery, along with the Danville Scouts, 4H members and local organizations. **Informational procedures will start at 6:00 PM.** The entrance of the cemetery is located off of Bloom Road, Danville, next to East End Fire Company.



WEDNESDAY, 5/20

Scouts and anyone in the Danville community are invited to place new flags at two Riverside Cemeteries starting at **6:00 PM.** Meet at Mt. Vernon Cemetery at the corner of Ave G and Ave F.



Anyone wishing to help place flags at the designated veteran headstones should meet at Odd Fellows Cemetery, Danville and/or Mt Vernon Cemetery, Riverside at 6:00pm on the designated days above.

The Veterans of Montour County will be hosting the annual Memorial Day parade and ceremonies on May 25, 2026. The ceremonies will begin at approximately **09:45-10:00 a.m.** at the bridge next to Riverfront Park to honor those lost and buried at sea. From that point, the parade will advance from Front Street down Mill Street to Memorial Park. At Memorial Park, a program will be presented at **11:00am**, that will allow those present to join with their neighbors to remember all veterans whose sacrifices have helped to preserve our basic rights and freedoms.



Large floats, Fire trucks, and Emergency vehicles will assemble on West Front Street next to the river. All other parade participants will assemble on West Market Street between the Court House and the Commonwealth Bank. **This is a change from past parades to alleviate congestion on West Market Street.**



Veterans marching in the parade can continue to assemble in the bank parking lot next to the courthouse on West Market Street and join in the parade when it passes. A van will be available from Rabbit Transit to transport any veteran unable to walk in the parade. The van is handicap accessible with a loading ramp for wheelchairs.



Our Memorial Day service will commence at **11:00am** in the Memorial Park located on Bloom Road across from the Grove Presbyterian Church in Danville. Feel free to bring a lawn chair for your comfort.

In case of rain, the park ceremony will be held in the Danville Middle School Auditorium.
